Annunciation Service Project



Join us for our annual Annunciation Service Project with Habitat for Humanity "to build safe, affordable housing" for a family in Northern Illinois, "that comes from a desire to

put God's love into action".

Based on feedback from parishioners and recommendations from Habitat for Humanity, we have selected Friday and Saturday, May 17th and 18th for Annunciation's Service Project. See the sign-up sheet on the Communication Wall. Sign up to work from 8-4 for either one day or two. Volunteers age 16-17 must have a parent working with them for the entire day. The donation to Habitat is \$1200 for the two days, and based on 10 volunteers would be \$120 per person. If people want to work half a day, they can sign up to work at the Habitat Re-Store in Waukegan. If you can't be on site, but still want to participate, you can sign up to provide food or contribute to lunch or snacks for the volunteers. 
