THE FAMILY OF ABRAHAM

Abraham (Abram) / Sarah (Sarai)

Abraham married Sarah (see Genesis 11:29).

Through Hagar, Sarah's handmaiden, Abraham fathered Isaac (see Genesis 16:1-4). After Sarah's death, Abraham married Keturah, through whom he had six children, named in Genesis 25:1-2.

Isaac / Rebekah

Isaac married Rebekah (see Genesis 25:20-26).
