

Our Odyssey of the Mind Balsa Wood Team Placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at the State Competition in Orlando this weekend, and received the highest honor of the Odyssey of the Mind Competition, the <u>Renatra Fusca</u> Award, for their exceptional creativity. This award granted them the opportunity to compete at the World Finals in Iowa this May- and that is no small task. To put it in perspective - there were a total of 820 teams across the state of Florida that competed regionally. 263 of those teams advanced to the State Tournament, and now only 31 of the Florida teams are advancing to World Finals. # History

- In 2016, the Florida Housing Finance Corporation approved funding for a Small Counties Demonstration Project to house homeless families who have children in school.
- The EscaRosa Coalition on the Homeless became aware of the program and facilitated a meeting between the Housing Finance Agency, the Santa Rosa School District and Milton Housing Authority.
- After a series of meetings and calls the pilot is now ready to begin.

- Students' academic success will improve and family engagement in schools will increase,
- Family income will increase, and
- Families will remain stably housed after the first year.

# Who is eligible?

Students who are eligible for McKinney-Vento Services and enrolled in the Santa Rosa County School District



# McKinney-Vento Definition

- Children or youth who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence, including children and youth:
  - Sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason
  - Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations
  - Living in emergency or transitional shelters, or who are abandoned in hospitals

### What must families do to participate?

- ✓ Meet with COL Staff and begin application process
- ✓ Complete the Family Sustainability Plan
- ✓ Meet with ECOH to determine financial eligibility
- ✓ Agree to follow Attendance Policy
- ✓ Participate in Case Management
- ✓ Support child's school success
- ✓ Provide all financial documents and participate in orientation with Milton Housing Authority
- ✓ Be responsible for utilities and a minimum of \$50/month for rent
- ✓ Set goals and meet with Family Promise Case Manager twice a month for the first month and then monthly for 11 months



COL Staff Case Manage students and Family Promise case manages parent/guardian Student is McKinney Vento Eligible

Housing Authority inspects rental and lease is signed!

Parent/Guardian completes referral with COL Staff

Family receives housing voucher and finds rental unit in SRC

COL staff submit referral to the ECOH

Milton Housing
Authority
determines rental
voucher eligibility
and conducts
orientation with
family

ECOH Staff meet with family and collect eligibility documents


