STUDENT dress code



What we don't allow.

- Long or short-sleeved t-shirts. Ever. (Boys & Girls)
- Hoodies or sweat shirts. (Boys & Girls)
- Jeans. (Boys & Girls)
- Shorts. (Boys & Girls)
- Tennis shoes or sandals. (Boys & Girls)
- High-heeled shoes. (Girls)
- Combat, hunting or work boots of any kind. (Boys & Girls)
- High-top laced boots that do not meet the shoe criteria. (Boys & Girls)
- Over-sized clothing or belts. (Boys & Girls)
- Baseball caps, caps or hats of any kind. (Boys & Girls)
- Jewelry on boys except for watches or rings conservatively worn.
- Excessive jewelry, i.e., nose rings, lip rings, or more than one set of earrings on girls.
- Poorly-groomed hair worn below the shirt collar. (Boys)
- Bright or loud hair colors (blue, purple, orange...etc.) (Boys & Girls)
- Bangs long enough to cover the eyes. (Boys & Girls)

School Dress Code: A set of rules, written and posted, specifying the required manner of dress at school.

What we look for (boys).

- Shirt tails must be tucked in unless the shirt worn is a polo or an otherwise straight-hemmed shirt.
- Belts should be worn when shirts are tucked in.
- Tasteful, dark-colored dress shoes or boots with rubber soles.
- Dress button-down or v-neck or round-neck sweaters (when sweaters are worn). Sweater material must be a knit.
- Shirts with collars.
- Dress slacks.



What we look for (girls).



- Skirts or dresses (no more than 1" above the knee). No denim material.
- Dress pants or capris.
- Dress blouses or tops. No low-cut nor belly-bearing blouses or tops.
- Knit sweaters. No hoodies.
- Dress shoes or boots of any color.
- Light make-up. (Teens.)
