## Rules \& Regs

## Entry Requirements

This high school tournament is managed by The Ohio High School Bowling Program under the sponsorship and supervision of Elder High School, Cincinnati, Ohio. This tournament will observe the rules of participation and play established by the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA). Participation is by invitation only and an invitation to participate is offered to any 20212022 Division I or Division II Ohio high school bowling team that is from a school classified by the State of Ohio as a "private" or "non-public" school. A school may enter two (2) boys and/or two (2) girls teams.

Due to facility considerations, The maximum number of participating teams is limited to 48 and will be determined on a 1st come-1st paid basis based on the postmark date of the paid entry. (See page 4 for details). No unpaid entries will be reserved. It is anticipated that this tournament will be an early "sell-out". Tournament management reserves the right to balance the boys \& girls fields with an even number of gender teams for lane assignment purposes. Tournament management also reserves the right to make any/all on-site adjustments/changes as it deems necessary.

## Spectator admission: \$8.00. Children age 6 \& under: no admission charge.

Each team may admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers (subject to OHSAA policies, TBA) and two (2) coaches at no charge. Proceeds go to the Ohio High School Bowling Program and Elder H.S.

## Tournament Format

There are four (4) separate team divisions: varsity boys, JV boys, varsity girls, \& JV girls. Five (5) participating bowlers per team. The format is the same for all divisions.
Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl 2 regular games and 6 Baker games. Based on the total scores from the Qualifying Round, the top 4 or 8 teams (depending on number of teams in each division) will advance to the Championship Round. All ties for advancing team positions will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.
The scores from the Qualifying Round will only be used to: A) determine the teams that advance to the Championship Round; B) the lane assignments of the teams in the Championship Round and, C) to select a boys and girls 5-member all-tournament team. The scores from the Qualifying Round do not carry over to the Championship Round. 8 teams in each division will advance to the Championship Round. If there are less than 8 teams entered in a division, 4 teams will advance.
Championship Round: The Championship Round for the four (4) or eight (8) advancing teams in each division will consist of an "eliminator" format consisting of two (2) Baker games, total score. The field will be reduced from 8 teams to 4 teams, to 2 teams or 4 teams to 2 teams. All ties for advancing positions in any Championship Round will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.
Team Game Substitutions - A coach is free to sub any bowler at any time for any reason in any frame or game "at will". However, the individual team game score must be posted as a "sub-bowler" score and will not be credited to either the starting or replacement bowler.
Awards: The 1st place team in each varsity division will receive a team trophy. The 1st and 2nd place teams in each division will receive individual medals for their athletes. The top five (5) members of the boys and the girls all-tournament team will each receive a medal.
