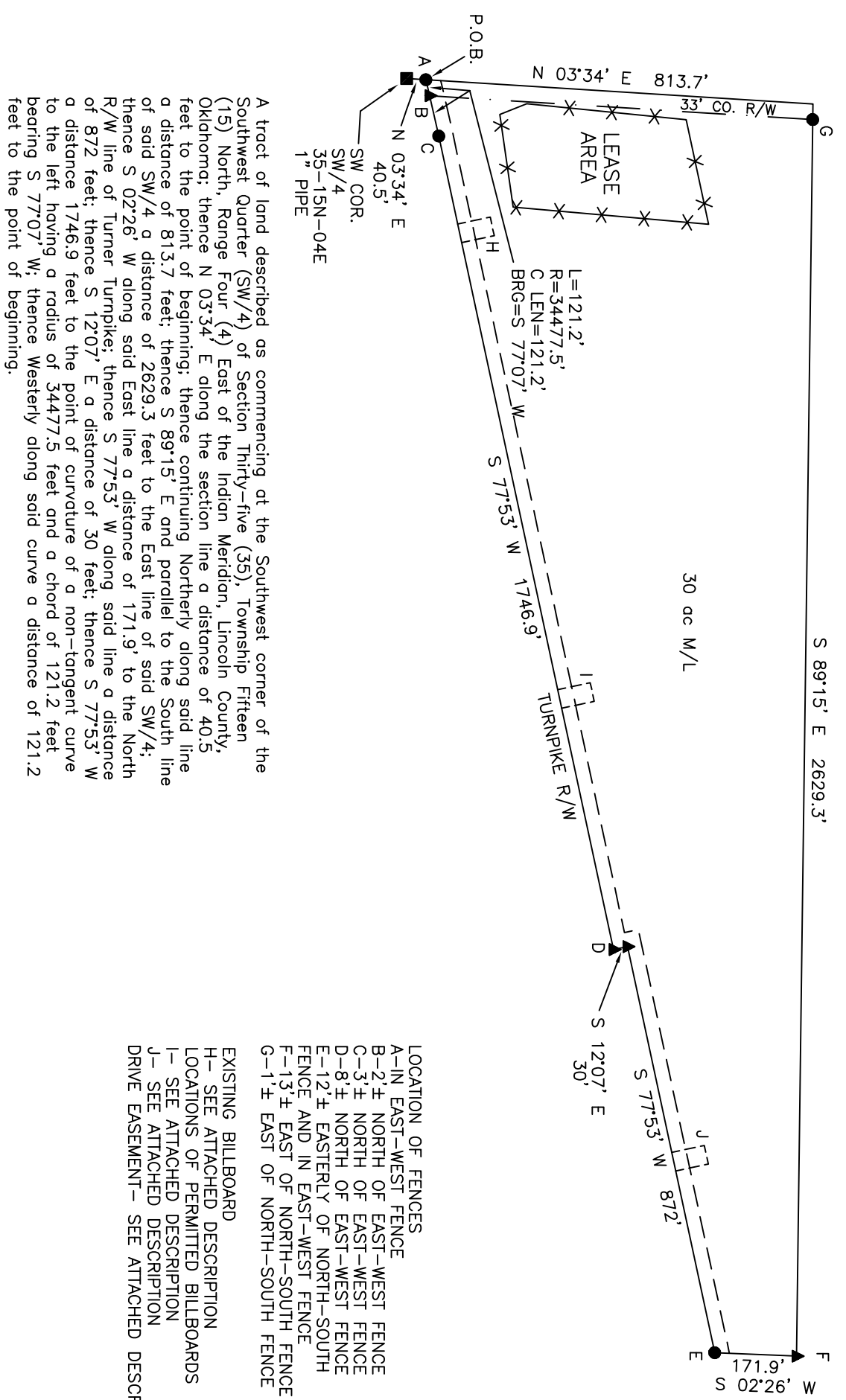


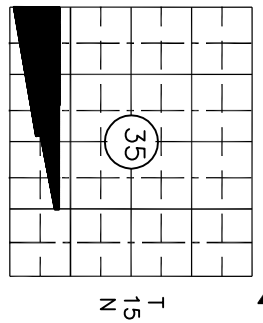
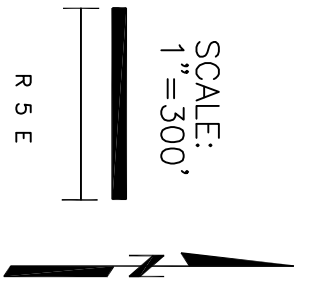

A tract of land described as commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Four (4) East of the Indian Meridian, Lincoln County, Oklahoma; thence N 03°34' E along the section line a distance of 40.5 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing Northerly along said line a distance of 813.7 feet; thence S 89°15' E and parallel to the South line of said SW/4 a distance of 2629.3 feet to the East line of said SW/4; thence S 02°26' W along said East line a distance of 171.9' to the North R/W line of Turner Turnpike; thence S 77°53' W along said line a distance of 872 feet; thence S 12°07' E a distance of 30 feet; thence S 77°53' W a distance of 1746.9 feet to the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve to the left having a radius of 34477.5 feet and a chord of 121.2 feet bearing S 77°07' W; thence Westerly along said curve a distance of 121.2 feet to the point of beginning.
