

# REQUEST FOR EXONERATION

The Mountain View School District provides an opportunity for exoneration from having to pay the two school per capita taxes that each adult resident is subject to each year; these include the school per capita Act 511 and Act 679 taxes; both of which are a flat rate of \$5.00 for a total of \$10.00.

There are three categories under which you may qualify for exoneration of the per capita taxes.

1. You are at least sixty-five (65) years of age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the tax year;
2. You suffer from a chronic illness or for which you can submit documentation. (A request for exoneration under this condition requires proof each tax year of said illness.)
3. You suffer from some financial hardship. Please note that documentation must be submitted and financial hardship is based on the decision of the school board, not the tax collector. (A request for exoneration under this condition also requires proof for each tax year.)

To request exoneration, simply complete this form below and return this to your tax collector. Please be sure to include your date of birth if you are over the age of 65 and sign and date the form in the spaces provided.

Please note that all requests for exoneration are subject to approval by the School Board and can be voided by the Board at its discretion.
