



TRASH & RECYCLING SERVICES AVAILABLE

- Prices vary based on your location. The more trash you throw away, the more you pay. You must have the trash service to get the recycling service.
- Recycling bins are dropped off to the customer on the first day of service. Customers provide their own trash cans.
- Call to find out your pick up day.
- Areas serviced for curbside are expanding throughout Athens and Hocking Counties. Call or fill out the online contact form to express interest and find out if your road is being considered.

GLASS

Rinse and remove caps. All colors can be mixed. Labels need not be removed.



BEVERAGE CANS

Please rinse.



MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

Glossy paper, glossy junk mail.



#1 - #7 PLASTICS

Plastic bottles, such as milk jugs, pop bottles, shampoo and detergent bottles. Clamshells and containers such as those used for salad, cottage cheese, yogurt, and berries. No Styrofoam.



TIN/STEEL CANS & ALUMINUM SCRAP

Pet food cans, fruit and vegetable cans, etc. Aluminum foil, pie pans and other small scrap. Material must be free of food. Labels need not be removed.



PAPERBOARD & CARDBOARD

Cereal boxes, cracker boxes, pop & beer cartons, paper towel rolls, paper egg cartons, etc. Brown corrugated, paper grocery sacks, brown/manila envelopes. Remove plastic inserts and flatten.



NEWSPAPER

Inserts can be included.



MIXED PAPER

(Non-glossy) Letterhead, copy paper, colored paper, non-glossy junk mail, envelopes.
