



Come and Take It Barrel Race Rules

GENERAL RULES

- All entries will run together. Each day will be a random draw; you may select your time slot preference (no quarantees).
- Times carry over to the classes you enter.
- All fees must be paid before you will be added to the draw.
- All classes must be declared and paid for prior to your run. It is the rider's responsibility to make sure they are entered in correct classes.
- · All contestants (even minors) must have a complete and legible W9 form on file before winnings will be released.
- · No overnight tie outs allowed; horses staying overnight must be stalled.
- Exhibition names will be called; draw will be posted.
- CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED NO MORE THAN TWO (2) MINUTES TO BEGIN RUN from the time name is called until they break the timer. You cannot enter arena and make a circle; you must maintain forward motion. Violations of these rules are subject to disqualification.
- · Cash or credit card only at event (5% fee for credit cards)
- No refunds. You can substitute your horse with no fees before your first run, you can substitute your rider, or you can sell your entire
 entry. Futurity/Derby/Slot/First Timer's Slot changes must be made prior to your first run.

First Timer's Futurity Slot contestants cannot sell their slot to someone who is not already entered in the First Timer's Slot race (remember, this class has a specific set of rules).

- Dress code. Western hat or helmet, boots, long pants and long sleeve shirt (no collar is fine) are required. Full dress code is not
 required for Exhibitions. Hat must remain on your head for entire run or you are subject to a \$10 hat fine payable at the office.
- Important Dates

November 1: Entries Open

December 16: Postmark deadline for pre-entry draw

December 23: Pre-entry draw will be posted to www.twistedsistersproductions.com

ENTRY FEES

- Exhibitions: \$5 each
- Open: \$75 Saturday (plus \$10 office fee), \$75 Sunday (plus \$10 office fee) enter both days with one entry transaction and office fee is \$15
- Youth: (16 & under as of January 1, 2021) \$50 Saturday (plus \$10 office fee), \$50 Sunday (plus \$10 office fee) enter both days with one entry transaction and office fee is \$15; if same horse/rider combination carries over to open, open office fee is waived
- Futurity: \$350 (includes \$15 office fee); if same horse/rider combination carries over to open, open office fee is waived
- Futurity Slot: \$1,000, must enter Futurity
- First Timer's Futurity Slot: \$500, must enter Futurity **SEE ENTRY RULES NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**
- Derby: \$215 (includes \$15 office fee); if same horse/rider combination carries over to open, open office fee is waived

Stalls

Thursday - Saturday: \$80 per stall, includes one bag of shavings**

Friday - Saturday: \$60 per stall, includes one bag of shavings**

Saturday only: \$40 per stall, includes one bag of shavings

Shavings must be purchased on site, no outside shavings allowed. \$9/bag on site

2 free exhibitions for first 100 stalls purchased; no refunds.

RV Hook Ups - only 75 hook ups available

Thursday - Saturday: \$120 per hook up

Friday - Saturday: \$80 per stall, includes one bag of shavings**

Saturday only: sold on site only, if available

DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

First Timer's Futurity Slot Race Rules

- First timers slot is open to any jockey that has **never** entered or competed in a futurity slot race, this includes "carry over" futurity slot races **AND** the horse can never have entered or competed in a futurity slot race
- May not enter the COME and TAKE IT Futurity Slot Race AND the First Timer's Futurity Slot Race
- · Limited to 15 entries!
- Entry deadline is Friday, December 18. There will be no late entries accepted
- · An entry list will be posted publicly to assist in the "vetting" of eligibility of jockeys and horses
- Entry fee is \$500, with 95% payout
- The number of places to be paid will be determined based on the final number of entries; no fewer than 2 places to be paid
- · Placing will be based on the fastest time of the two futurity rounds
- If you want to protest an entry's eligibility, email info@twistedsistersproductions.com by December 30, 2020. Contestants ruled to be ineligible will forfeit their entry fee

Futurity Rules

- Futurity is open to horses foaled in 2016 or later (4 & 5 year olds)
- Horse can not have been entered prior to Nov 15, 2020
- The futurity will consist of 2 go rounds and average payout
- 2D, 3/4 second split
- All checks will be made out to owner on papers
- · Horse papers required at time of entry
- Owners W9 must be received prior check distribution
- · Minimum of \$10,000 added
- \$350 entry fee, including \$15 office fee
- 85% payout of jackpot, 100% of added money
- · Entry includes one exhibition

Futurity Slot Rules

- · Must enter Futurity
- · Placing will be based on the fastest time of the two futurity rounds
- \$1,000 entry fee, 95% payout
- Straight payout

Derby Rules

- Derby is open to horses foaled in 2013 or later (5 to 8 year olds)
- Eligible to complete for up to 3 years after their futurity year

- · Consist of 2 go rounds
- 2D, 3/4 second split
- · All checks will be made out to owner on papers
- · Horse papers required at time of entry
- Owners W9 must be received prior check distribution
- \$215 entry fee, including \$15 office fee
- 85% payout of jackpot

Open Rules

- · 4D with half second splits
- \$75 Saturday (plus \$10 office fee), \$75 Sunday (plus \$10 office fee); enter both days with one entry transaction and office fee is \$15
- Saturday and Sunday are separate races, minimum of \$3,000 added to each race
- 80% payout of jackpot, 100% of added money, progressive payout

Youth Rules

- · 4D with half second splits
- · Saturday and Sunday are separate races
- 80% payout of jackpot, progressive payout
- · You can enter the Youth as a standalone run and carry your time to other classes

Twisted Sisters Productions may disqualify or deny entry to any contestant and/or horse who is dangerous to the rider, other individuals, animals or property.
