1. Parking is permitted only in designated hard-surfaced spots.

Any violators parking on the grass may be ticketed. This is to keep critical areas cleared from congestion so that emergency vehicles will have easy access to all areas at any time, as well as improve visibility for vehicles and pedestrians, especially children. There are plenty of designated parking spots in the main parking lots (D-E-F) by the Hamlin Road and John R. Road entrances.

2. Gas grills are recommended.

If you plan on grilling in the park, we recommend bringing gas grills only. Charcoal grills are strongly discouraged as they pose a safety hazard, and the park has no safe place to discard the hot coals.

3. Alcohol is not allowed anywhere inside the park.

This policy will be strictly enforced everywhere in the park, including the parking lots. Offenders may be ticketed for ordinance violation, fined, and removed from the park.

4. Tents/canopies.

Tents and pop-up awnings/canopies are allowed under special regulations. You do not need special permission if your canopy is no larger than 12' x 12'. **EMS requires that all tents/canopies must have a minimum 12 feet unobstructed safety and maintenance route adjacent/around all 4 sides.** To avoid irrigation and electric lines, please ask park staff for guidelines if your stakes are long. 5. Pets are welcome, but only on a 6-foot leash.

No matter how friendly your pet may be, all pets must be on a six-foot leash and under your immediate control. Please respect other park users around you.

6. First Aid is available at the Tournament Headquarters Tent.

However, should you or anyone in your tournament make a call to "911," please also notify the Tournament or Park Staff so they can direct any medical/ambulance personnel to the correct location as quickly and efficiently as possible.
