

TOWN OF STRATTON
SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES

The Stratton School board held its yearly budget meeting on Thursday, January 27, 2011 at 6 P.M. at the Town Office. Attending the meeting were Thomas Montemagni, Siobhan Eddy Young, Lorraine M. Weeks-Newell and Laura Hawksley, Town Treasurer. Also present was WCSU Superintendent, Steven John and Finance Officer, Frank Rucker.

Lorraine Newell called the meeting to order at 6:07.

Laura Hawksley provided the Board with the following information:

- Current budget for 2010/2011
- Student list with attending schools
- Copy of the 2012 proposed budget

Using the present budget, Ms. Hawksley provided Frank Rucker with estimated figures based on information at hand and a 3% increase. At the time of the meeting, the State had not released the State average amounts for tuition for grades K-6 and 7-12. Therefore, the amount of \$10,900 was tentatively set for grades K-6 and \$12,225 for High School, grades 7-12. Thomas Montemagni made the motion to finalize the budget at the next School Board meeting to be held on February 3, 2011 at 7 P.M. when the tuition information would be available. Siobhan Young seconded.

Correspondence was received from the Mountain School announcing a tuition freeze for the 2011/2012 school year.

As there was no other business at hand, Thomas Montemagni made the motion to adjourn with Siobhan Young seconding.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 P.M.
