Riggy's Open Scotch Doubles Championships

NOTE: Riggy's Sports Grill is a non-smoking venue. An outside smoking area is available.

Times:

- Doors open for registration and practice at 11:00 a.m. Start time is Noon.
- Finals will be conducted immediately after the qualifying matches are completed.

Format:

- Open Division only - No Handicap
- The format will be Round Robin with 3-4 teams in each group. The top 4 teams, based on total games won, will advance to the finals. In the event of a tie for a finals position, a race to 3 in 9-Ball will be conducted with alternating breaks.
- Each match will consist of 4 games of 9-Ball and 3 games of 8-Ball.
- All 7 games will be played in each match.
- Players will flip a coin to begin match.
- The winner of the flip chooses the game to start (8-Ball or 9-Ball) and will get the break.
- If 9-Ball is chosen as the game to start, 4 games of 9-Ball are played, followed by 3 games of 8-Ball, or vice versa, 3 games of 8-Ball followed by 4 games of 9-Ball.
- The breaks will be alternating. Each team will rack for itself.
- At the beginning of the match, each team will select its order of play. That order will continue throughout the entire match and may not be changed between games.
- Players will be allowed one 30-second conference each game while at the table. Otherwise, players are permitted to talk to each other for no longer than 5 seconds while changing places at the table. The first offense to the 5-second rule will result in a warning. Subsequent offenses will be treated as ball-in-hand fouls.

Eligibility: Players must be currently playing in a league sanctioned by ACS, APA, BCAPL, NAPA, TAP, UPA, or VNEA. Teams must be composed of two players from the same league. Participants must have played at least 5 matches over a minimum of 5 weeks during the past two years' league sessions. Verification of eligibility may be required. **NOTE: NO INDIVIDUALS CLASSIFIED AS ADVANCED OR MASTERS PLAYERS MAY PARTICIPATE.**

Equipment: (7) 7-ft Olhausen Pro tables, with Simonis 860 cloth and Aramith balls, will be used.

Entry Fee: \$20 per person (\$40 per 2-player team)

Prize Fund: Approximately 1 place will be paid for every 4 entries. Based on a 16-team field, the payout would be: 1st Place \$360, 2nd \$210, 3rd \$160, and 4th \$110. We expect the field to be 12 to 16 teams. The prize fund payout will change proportionally based on the entries. The Georgia ACS League Association will add \$200 to the prize fund. Riggy's Sports Grill will donate all table time.
