

**REGULAR MEETING**  
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE  
DECEMBER 09, 2019

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on DECEMBER 09, at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pam Blakely, Alderman Timothy Derise, Alderman Bryan Glatter, Alderman Donald Martin, Alderwoman Madison Saunier and Alderwoman Sarah Trahan.

ALSO, PRESENT: Town Clerk Shirley Wyles, Town Attorney Ted Ayo, Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer, Pelican Waste & Debris representative Tommy Thibodeaux, Twin Parish Port representative Wendell Verret and 7 guests.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of November 11, 2019 as reviewed." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to authorize payment of monthly bills as reviewed." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier, "moved to extend the agenda to add Acadiana Broadband to Old Business." Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to table Acadiana Broadband permission to offer services within the Town of Delcambre until contract is amended to read as Town of Erath's contract (Ted Ayo to provide) and legal has reviewed and presented to Board of Aldermen. Item to be placed on January 2020 agenda." Motion Carried:

DISCUSSION: Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer provided the following update to members of Council and guest on the water meter construction and installation project; "Everything is going good and will shortly be approaching the addendum work and we are still waiting on the Railroad permit".

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve the amending of ORDINACE Sec. 4-2. Fireworks; (B) Possession; Sale; (4) To The Possession, Use, Explosion and Ignition On the Following Holidays:  
A. July 4; Or B. December 23 Through January 1;  
To Be Permitted Between the Hours of 7:00 A.M. And 10:00 P.M. And Additionally On January 1 Until 2:00 A.M. And During the Day On January 1 As Above Enumerated. Amending dates of sale to the week prior to and on July 4<sup>th</sup> and December 20<sup>th</sup> through January 1<sup>st</sup>" Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve the ORDINACE - SEC. 2-55 Compensation Of The Mayor, Alderman, Clerk, Chief Of Police And All Other Municipal Officers..." Motion Carried.

DISCUSSION: Connie Langlinais, resident of the Town of Delcambre, present to the members of Council and guest the great need of a park for the children of Delcambre. Ms. Langlinais expressed her concern of the current park at the edge of Town and its safety issues. All agree with Ms. Langlinais and would like to find a good location for this new park. Twin Parish Port representative, Wendell Verret states Twin Parish Port will assist with a portion of funding when ready.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve the renewal of Intergovernmental agreement between Twin Parish Port and the Town of Delcambre for police assistance." Motion Carried.

DISCUSSION: Town Clerk discussed the increase in group insurance rates and certain staff's request in being dropped from full coverage to the Town paying for a supplemental coverage to their current Medicare coverage. Current Group Insurance is provided by United Health Care with Keith Guidry as agent for the Town of Delcambre. Due to the Town having less than 20 full time employees covered by the group insurance as provided, UHC is deemed secondary to Medicare being primary. Secondary rates are same as if primary,

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and seconded by Alderman Sarah Trahan "moved to table discussion and decisions on group insurance until January 2020 meeting when the Town's agent may be present". Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to move into executive session for discussion of personnel matter". Motion Carried.

DISCUSSION: Mayor request support of members of Council in terminating Carol Broussard as Operator of Gas, Water & Waste Water Operator. Carol Broussard introduced Chellie Godeaux as witness on his behalf. Ms. Godeaux states Town Hall did nothing to assist her company with preparations of Public Awareness Plan and request 2019 records for said plan. Ms. Godeaux request all documents be provided through Town's Attorney so she may have no dealing with Town Hall.
