PIGEON CITIZEN DIES

Jacob W. Schluchter died at his home at 308 South Mason street, Dearborn, Michigan on Saturday of last week after a short illness.

Deceased was born in Waterloo County, Ontario on January 22, 1853. He settled on a farm near Caseville when a young man and later moved on a farm one mile east of Pigeon where he lived for many years until he moved to Dearborn in 1917.
