The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. in the City Hall Commission Room.

Present: Mayor Lentz, Commissioners Krug, Stirton, Boller, and Edwards. City Clerk Kim Clausen and City Attorney Kevin Hill were also present.

Discuss the Future of the Armory and Potential Options for the Building

NEKAP stated how much money that they and their employees spend in the city of Horton at businesses etc.. and how they assist people in need of help on their utility bills and deposits (not necessarily from the NEKAP in Horton). They stressed the importance of needing the Armory for the service to remain in Horton.

Mayor Lentz stated on behalf of Steve Davies that the school is going to look into helping out by paying the city for use of the Armory for basketball games and practices. Davies also stated that they could possibly provide some kids to help keep the facility clean.

The city thinks that with the help of NEKAP increasing their amount for rent, the school district paying for practices and ballgames at the facility, the hospital paying for housing of the ambulance, and increasing the rates for general citizens who utilize the building, the city would be able to afford to upkeep the building.
