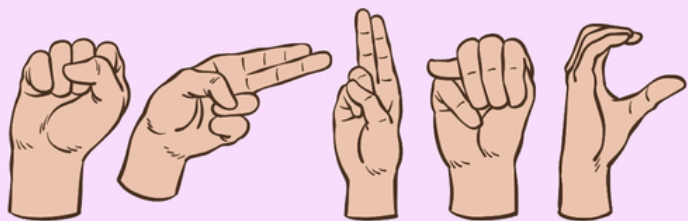
CHANGE

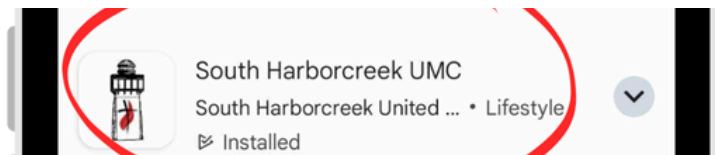
