

#### Home Learning activity of the week:

#### School Leavers:

Letters and Sounds game Roly Poly (Attached).

Maths - Play with a dice or number dominos to improve number recognition.

Also look at 2D and 3D shapes - see how many they can name. Concentrate on square/cube, rectangle/cuboid, Triangle/pyramid, circle/sphere plus cone, hexagon and pentagon. You can add in other shapes if needed. Try and link these shapes back to everyday objects such as road signs, letters through the post, lorry shapes, wheels, washing machine windows etc etc.

Literacy - Encourage your child to make a shopping list, such as buying food for a party. Mark making and phonics are extremely important when starting school so make sure you focus on letter name **and** sound.
