Call to order	Andrea Hebert
Data Review	Data through Q2 2024, not necessarily new since last mtg but set up to view as trended. Question re: Time to transfer decision, is everyone adding this to image trend? Next time Michael runs he will review to compare # transfers vs #s of decision to tx. Also with decision to tx and transfer times, shared Benchmark goals again as region and discussion that facilities can take these back locally and also make them tighter for facility needs, but ideally our goals as a region. Per data we still may have opportunities re: times, however capacity issues at L2 facilities leading to longer acceptance times, or lack of transport capacity leading to extended length of stay. Need to eval data re: decision times if accurate, then ID what we can control as RTAC group re: goals (may only be r/t Ct times and decision to tx times)
Anticoagulation Magnet	Discussed viability of project, perhaps may be more appropriate to focus on "falls work". Many of PI coordinators are doing injury prevention work as well, Andrea to ask Amanda to join us at next mtg, or suggestion to include/have PI and Injury Prevention join together for these mtgs in future? Andrea will talk Amanda re: this
PI Funds	Michael has ordered 8 sets of ICD 2025 books, slightly > \$1000 for out \$1000 PI funds used this fiscal year and thank you to Michale for finding add'l funds from another location to be able to order all books needed.
PI NC RTAC vs state PI plan and SERTAC document	<p>Reviewed PI NC RTAC plan for 2025 with PI indicators added from state PI plan. Great discussion about things we may want to add but unsure if we will have access to data, made few changes to PI indicators i.e. instead of looking at peds Chest imaging for transfer outs, we would want to look at all peds imaging to ensure compliance with WI guidelines. Michael to explore the areas we would like to incorporate to see if we can get data on them.</p> <p>Reviewed SERTAC document-is ideally a tool that can be taken back to your facility/resource, not intended to be something that all of NC RTAC monitors. Met with Kelly from SE RTAC group, document shareable and again may need to take back to facility level to determine what is monitored and how as facility policies may dictate something slightly different.</p>
