

Door-To-Door Residential Solicitors

Dear Residents,

There have been several questions about why the Holleybrooke Homeowners Association can't stop solicitation in our neighborhood. Holleybrooke and Cobblestone **are not** a "nonsoliciting neighborhood!" Only the "common areas, such as entrance area, pool and playground" are identified as such.

I have listed below the section of the Codes of the County of Spotsylvania, that applies to the residents. If you have any questions, please refer to County.

The Code of County of Spotsylvania, Virginia (Sec. 18-26) states: Door-to door solicitor means a person who goes from door to door visiting multifamily or family dwellings or any other residential premises in the county for the following purposes:

- (1) Selling any goods, wares, merchandise or services or accepting or subscriptions or orders therefor, or for any other purposes which results in pecuniary gain to such person;
- (2) Accepting or requesting contributions for any charitable purpose.

Sec. 18-31.-Entering posted premises.

No door-to-door solicitor shall enter upon any residential premises for soliciting, when the owner or occupant has displayed a "**NO SOLICITING**" sign on such premises.

Sec. 18-32.- Refusal to leave premises upon request.

It shall be unlawful from any door-to-door solicitor to remain in or on any residential premises after the owner or occupant has requested that he leaves.
