Please Read Carefully

Dear Student Volunteer and Parents,

We are so glad that you want to be a student volunteer in the Preschool and Children's Ministry. The primary goal of the Preschool and Children's Ministry is to see children accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and grow in their relationship with Him. Our mission is to partner with parents to teach kids about the Bible.

Parents, before signing the attached permission slip, please discuss the following guidelines with your youth:

- **Spiritual Life:** Youth must have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, and attend Sunday morning worship every other week. (unless attending an earlier/later service on the same day)
- **Dress Code:** Remember, we are to represent Jesus Christ and look as professional as possible. Youth should wear neat, modest, comfortable clothing and makeup.
- **Conduct:** Do what is pleasing to the Lord in and out of the classroom. Youth should be a Christian example at all times. Please be careful when playing with the children; do not play rough. Remember to always use a loving voice and actions when guiding the behavior of preschoolers and children. Youth should not be using their cell phones while serving, except for an emergency.
- **Attendance:** If youth cannot serve, please call the ministry director as soon as possible. If an emergency arises on the day youth are scheduled to serve, call the ministry director's cell 678-520-5775. Also, please attend scheduled ministry training opportunities.
- **Arrival:** Youth should arrive at the assigned area of ministry 15 minutes before the session begins and must wear a nametag (obtained at check-in area)
- **Safety/Security:** The adult teacher is responsible for receiving and releasing the children at the door according to their security tags. An adult teacher must be present with the children at all times. Youth are not to take the children into the restroom. Please be familiar with the Emergency Bag located on the back of the classroom door. Youth will be given a Preschool and Children's Ministry Handbook and a copy of our Child Protection Policies; these policies should be followed at all times.
- **Dismissal:** While the teacher dismisses the children to the parents, we would like the youth to assist in keeping the children busy during this transition. We would appreciate assistance cleaning up the classroom at the end of the session as well.

Preschool and Children's Ministry Behavior Guidelines

There are 3 guiding principles within each Berean Kids environment:

In Preschool Ministry we say:

1. Be Kind (no inappropriate language)
2. Be Safe (do not hurt self or others)
3. Be Clean (do not destroy property)

In Children's Ministry we say:

1. We are here to meet with others and meet with God!
2. When someone is talking, I'm listening!
3. Have fun!
