StoneGate Arts & Education Center Downtown

Classes set to begin at new facility in January

BEDFORD — Oct. 17 marked the general contractor's completion of StoneGate Arts & Education Center Downtown, 931 15th St., and the day when the City of Bedford took ownership from builders Patterson Horth of Indianapolis.

Funding for the \$4.4 million facility resulted, in part, from the City of Bedford's successful bid for the 2013 Stellar Communities Grant, and Bedford Mayor Shawna Girgis' goal to revitalize downtown, and provide educational and job training opportunities for local residents.

Girgis anticipates the building will serve as an anchor for the downtown area.

Designed by Matheu Architects of Bloomington, StoneGate will deliver education, training and arts to downtown Bedford. In addition to being the county's official learning center, the building will serve to spur an active downtown after regular business hours.

The building was designed with flexibility in mind, and numerous educational partners, local businesses, manufacturers, and user groups — such as Little Theatre of Bedford, Bedford Library, Lawrence County Museum and the Lawrence County Art Association —



provided input in the initial stages of the project with an eye toward the multi-use capacity of the facility.

StoneGate Downtown offers 14 classrooms, with classes through Ivy Tech Community College, Oakland City University and Vincennes

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University. Discussions for adding additional educational partners are ongoing.

The facility features a large performing arts space with seating for 125 people, three large computer labs and a smaller lab, as well as offices for StoneGate personnel, college coordinators, a room for college admission assessments, places to study and relax between classes and gallery space.

Each of the rooms in the center will be named for mayors of the city of Bedford. There have been 23 Bedford mayors, and 15 previous mayors have not been honored in the city. The new StoneGate facility has provided the city the opportunity to recognize them.

In addition to the various classrooms and assessment room bearing the names of former mayors, the performing arts auditorium will be

named Brinegar Hall.

Local artist Stephen Burton has agreed to create oil and canvas paintings of each of the mayors to hang in their respective rooms.

Students may take single classes, complete degrees or certificate programs at the facility. Additionally, StoneGate will partner with the North Lawrence Career Center to provide hands-on training to prepare students for the next generation of workforce development.

Furniture for the building arrived the week of Sept. 24, and installation of computers, printers, SmartBoards and other technology is under way.

Classes for all educational partners at StoneGate Downtown will begin in January. A ribbon-cutting and open house will take place at the end of November.
