## Essentials of Emergency Service Chaplaincy

**12 and 13 June 2018 (8 AM – 5 PM)**

This course provides the foundation for Fire/Rescue/EMS chaplain service and teaches an established and credentialed system of protocols in order to provide chaplaincy to emergency service workers and the public. ## CISM: Individual and Group Crisis Intervention

**14-16 June 2018 (8 AM – 6 PM all 3 days)**

This double course will cover both "Assisting Individuals in Crisis" and "Group Crisis Intervention". Program is designed to teach participants the fundamentals of, and specific protocols for, individual and group crisis interventions. Participants will leave with the knowledge and tools to provide several group crisis interventions, specifically demobilizations, defusings and the Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD). The need for appropriate follow-up services and referrals when necessary will also be discussed. This Level 100 class taught by Chaplain Paul Trumpore.
