

ABCs of Gun Safety

What you should do to stay safe.

A) If you find a gun in your house:

- Do not pick up the gun.
- Tell other kids not to pick up the gun.
- Tell an adult about the gun.

B) If you find a gun in your friend's house:

- Do not pick up the gun.
- Tell your friend not to pick up the gun.
- Tell an adult about the gun
- Get out of the house.

C) If you find a gun outside:

- Do not pick up the gun.
- Tell your friends not to pick up the gun.
- Run away if your friend picks up a gun.
- Tell an adult (parent, teacher, police officer) about any gun you find.

D) What to do when someone makes you angry:

- Resist violence.
- Talk to that person to try to make things better.
- Ask your teacher or parent to help you resolve the problem.
- Walk away.

E) What you can do to stay safe:

- Talk to your parents about gun safety.
- It is safest if there is no gun in the house.
- If there is a gun in the house, tell your parents that they need to keep the guns safe. They need to:
 - Keep guns locked up.
 - Keep bullets separate from the gun.
- Stay away from guns.
