- 1. Futurity Open to any horse which is a foal of 2012 or later (5 years & under). Horse must never have competed in any barrel race, rodeo, jackpot, or other futurities before December of the previous year. Horse may have run exhibition runs.
- 2. Derby Open to any horse which is a foal of 2010 or later (7 years & under).
- 3. Futurity/Derby Photocopy of the **front and back** of registration papers on registered horses must accompany nominations. Veterinarian affidavit of year of birth and complete description of unregistered horses must accompany nomination.
- 4. Futurity and Derby will be two runs and an average. Champions will be declared on a two run average.
- 5. Running order will be drawn for 1st go and 2nd go will be run in reverse order.
- 6. Nomination payments are due May 1, 2017 (Futurity @ \$120, Derby @ \$100) and June 1, 2017 (Futurity @ \$100, Derby @ \$70). Payments are to be made by TWO postdated cheques or cheque in full amount, or an e-transfer and they must be accompanied by an entry form. Late Fines will be \$50.00/payment.
- 7. Any NSF cheque or e-transfer will carry a \$50.00 service charge.
- 8. No buyouts or selling of futurity/derby entries will be allowed.
- 9. Substitutions will be accepted for death, illness, or unsoundness. Veterinarian affidavit of proof must accompany substitution along with a \$50.00 fee. An owner with a nominated horse may not substitute another horse (selling) from another owner. No Horse substitutions allowed after June 25, 2017.
- 10. Substitution of a rider is allowed and is free of charge as long as office is notified 1 hour prior to the 1st go.
- 11. No refunds for any reason.
- 12. Dress Code- long sleeve collared shirt, cowboy boots, cowboy hat or helmet will be enforced during the futurity, Derby and Open.
- 13. Self-Penning is allowed only in designated areas in this park. They cannot take up any parking area, but can be in the treed/shaded areas adjacent to where you camp.
- 14. Payout-

Futurity & Derby - 1st & 2nd go-30% of total prize money Average- 40% of total prize money 30 & under entries pays 4 monies in each go and average 31-60 entries pays 6 monies in each go and average 61-80+ entries pays 8 monies in each go and average

All horses may be subjected to a drug test, examination to meet registration identifications or examination for age discretion of management. Any horse examined and found to be of ineligible age, failing to meet registration description or failing to pass a drug free exam will be disqualified.
- Inhumane treatment of horse will not be tolerated on the grounds and will result in disqualification.
- Competitors must be ready when they are called or they will forfeit their run.
- Completion of entry form or payment of entry fee will indicate acceptance of all rules and regulations governing this event.
- Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained it is understood that each contestant/owner waives all claims against the Canada Day Wine Country Futurity/Derby & Open Barrel Racing, organizing body, workers, etc. for any injury, or loss of damages which may result in any way from the operations of activities of the Canada Day Wine Country Futurity/Derby & Open Barrel Race.

PEACHLAND RIDING CLUB ~ FACILITY AND HISTORY

The Peachland Riding Club was formed in 1969 by a small handful of volunteers and is currently one of the strongest and longest running riding clubs in the beautiful Okanagan Valley of British Columbia.

Our grounds are located on 8.3 acres of Municipality owned parkland, the Mountainview Park, and is maintained and managed by Peachland Riding Club volunteers with the help of the Peachland Municiality. We have direct access to miles and miles of beautiful trail riding systems. Our grounds have a lovely vintage two-story clubhouse with washrooms, small kitchen, office in the lower level and banquet/bar area with a capacity of 85 people on the upper. There is also a separate washroom building, concession building and fenced picnic area.

Our rodeo/riding arena is an outdoor 160' x 240' sand arena, with a 15' x 60' run in/out alleyway and a 60'x 75' holding pen access to alleyway. The footing was completely replaced in 2012 and has been carefully maintained for safety and consistency since. The arena fencing is currently 60% 2W Livestock products and the remaining portions are slated to be replaced by the end of 2017. The roughstock set up (chutes and back pens) and the timed event end (chutes/boxes and herringbone sorters) are all High-Hog steel. There is a two story announcer stand with office on lower level.

There is a warm up area that is approximately $100' \times 100'$ adjacent to the arena alleyway and holding pen. We also have 12 portable style $10' \times 10'$ stalls and 15 $10' \times 10'$ wood rail outdoor pens.

We have outdoor bleacher seating for approximately 250 people on one side of the arena and natural hillside where people can sit in the shade on their lawn chairs on the other side of the arena.

Although the club has hosted every equine event imaginable from English and western shows, breed shows, competitive trail rides to poker rides, Cowboy polo and 4H events, clinics, workshops and many social activities, for the past 25 years the club focus has been mainly gymkhana and barrel racing events. We have also hosted Little Britches and High School Rodeos, rodeo clinics and roping events for the past 11 years.

Our Canada Day Events started about 8 years ago and was strictly a barrel racing event in the beginning, then we added team roping about five years ago. Depending on when Canada Day lands in the week, these events have been 1-3 days long and usually have a social event included.
