## Tuition Information and Rates for the 2018-2019 School Year

### Contributing Parishioner Requirements

Each family receiving the parish-subsidized tuition rate must be active participants, registered in the parish. An active participant is one who attends mass regularly, works to support parish ministries, and contributes a minimum of \$780 annually (\$15 weekly) to the parish collection via weekly envelopes or on-line giving during the prior fiscal year (ending June 30th).

**New incoming** Corpus Christi Parish families are expected to contribute a minimum of \$15.00 per week to the church effective with enrollment to the school.

### Tuition for Non-Contributing Families

The Non-Contributing/Out of Parish/Non-Catholic rate applies to any family not registered at Corpus Christi, St. Maria Goretti or to registered families who do not meet the contribution criterion listed above.

### Registration Fees

For new students, a \$100.00, one time only, Registration Fee is required

For returning students, all tuition fees for the 2017-2018 school year must be up to date before registration can take place for the 2018-2019 school year.

**Current families must return a signed reregistration form and a signed tuition agreement to SCHOOL by Friday, January 26, 2018.**

### Order of Acceptance for Admission for New Students

1. Registered parishioners of Corpus Christi and St. Maria Goretti living within parish boundaries with Catholic children already in school
2. Registered parishioners of Corpus Christi and St. Maria Goretti living within parish boundaries who are new to the parish school community
  - a. Families new to the parish school community
  - b. Students transferring from other Catholic schools
3. Registered parishioners living outside parish boundaries with children already in school
4. Registered parishioners living outside the parish boundaries enrolling in Corpus Christi Catholic School for the first time
5. Catholic Students coming from a parish without a school and NOT assigned to another school
6. Catholic students coming from a parish which has closed its school enrollment
7. Non-Catholic students

## Tuition Payment Schedule (PreKindergarten, Kindergarten and Grades 1-8)

In an effort to keep tuition costs reasonable for our families, we do not employ a Tuition Payment Service. You will not receive a coupon book or monthly reminder that tuition is due. We ask families to make note of the due dates and send in tuition payments promptly.

Tuition checks must be made payable to Corpus Christi School. The first tuition payment must be received by JULY 15, 2018 in the tuition envelope /mailing envelope provided. This applies to any payment plan you have selected. Tuition may also be mailed directly to the Corpus Christi Parish Center Office during the summer.

No child will receive his/her classroom assignment or be admitted to school on the first day unless the first tuition payment (annually, semi-annually, quarterly or July and August monthly payments) has been made.

Tuition payments should be current by the beginning of each trimester. **Failure to meet this obligation may result in your child (children) being removed from Corpus Christi Catholic School.**

Failure to meet any of the above financial deadlines may result in your child being dropped from our roll if a waiting list for the grade exists regardless of your admission priority.
