WHAT YOU NEED

Different types of books or magazines. These do not need to have any writing in, picture books are great. Books such as 'First one hundred words' are good for encouraging children to point out things and people doing things.

HOW TO PLAY

Ask the toddler to point to something in the picture. "Show me," "Point to," "Where is?"

Start off with obvious things in the picture. Later on, try asking for smaller things or parts of things, such as "Where's the man's ear." You can also use the books to help find real things, such as "Where's your ear?" or looking at the book, "Where's the dog?" and then "Where's our dog?"
