




**Discuss with property owner a listing from a licensed contractor of items to be corrected to make the building at 319 Main Street safe per Ordinance #456.**

September 23, 2021

The Westmoreland City Council met on September 23, 2021 at the Community Center for a special meeting for the purpose of discussing with the property owner a listing from a licensed contractor of items to be corrected to make the building at 319 Main Street safe per Ordinance #456.

Governing Body members present: Mayor, Mark Goodenow; Councilmembers, Jim Smith, Mark Jack, Ashley Rice, Jeff Rosell.

Governing Body members absent: Waide Purvis.

City Staff present: City Attorney, Summer Dierks; Maintenance Supervisor, Robert Krohn and City Treasurer, Teresa Varriale.

Others present: Terry Tabb, Scott Schwinn, Lisa Schwinn and Kaylene Plummer.

There being a quorum present Mayor Goodenow called the meeting to order at 4:45 PM.

Scott Schwinn distributed the letter from the contractor who inspected the building. The main items that need to be repaired to make the building safe are the back stairs and the building's foundation.

Councilmember Rosell asked Mr. Schwinn how much time he would need to have the repairs completed. Mr. Schwinn replied that he would need one (1) year.


After some brief discussion, it was decided to allow six (6) months for the repairs, and then meet again at that time to discuss the progress.
