

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION ELEVEN OF VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER FIVE REGARDING THE ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: Section Eleven of Ordinance Number 5 of the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri shall be amended as set forth below, with language to be added underlined and language to be deleted ~~stricken~~:

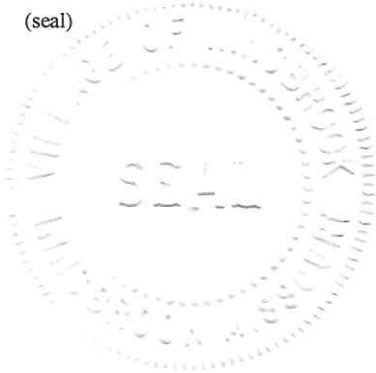
Section Eleven. Enactment of Ordinances.

The style of the ordinances of the Village of Innsbrook shall be as follows: "Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Innsbrook as follows:" No ordinance shall be passed except by bill, and no bill shall become an ordinance unless on its final passage a majority of the members ~~elected to~~ of the Board of Trustees shall vote therefor, and the ayes and nays shall be entered on the journal. Every proposed ordinance shall be introduced to the Board of Trustees in writing and shall be read by title or in full two times prior to passage, both readings may occur at a single meeting of the Board of Trustees. If the proposed ordinance is read by title only, copies of the proposed ordinance shall be made available for public inspection prior to the time the bill is under consideration by the Board of Trustees. All ordinances shall be in full force and effect from and after their passage after being duly signed by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and attested by the Village Clerk.

Section II: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect both from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Chairman and Board of Trustees.

Said Bill was passed and approved this Edy day of AUGUST, 2023, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two times prior to passage.
