Program Highlights

- 10 nights / 12-day journey through Israel, Palestine and Jordan.
- Explore some of the highlights in Tel Aviv, Haifa, Nazareth, Bethlehem, Petra Amman, Jerusalem and Wadi Rum.
- Take a dip in the **Dead Sea**, one of the most spectacular natural and spiritual landscapes in the world.
- Many a bucket list includes the ancient and remote dead city of **Petra**. Check it off your list as you visit this archeological wonder.
- Explore **Jerusalem** including a visit to the **Jewish Wailing Wall**, a walk along the **Via Dolorosa**, the **Church of Holy Sepulcher**, King David's tomb, the **Room of the Last Supper** and much more.

Cultural Exploration

- Explore **Wadi Rum** via Jeep where the weather and winds have carved the imposing skyscrapers of rock. The rock-scapes rise from the desert floor to heights of almost 6,000 feet. Explore the canyons and water holes where you may see 4,000-year-old rock drawings and other treasures in this yast wilderness.
- Explore **Yad Vashem**, a memorial to six million Jews who were killed in the Holocaust.
- Enjoy a special **dance performance** by the Batsheva Dance group at the Suzanne Dalal center.
- Visit the picturesque village of **Ein Karem**, the birthplace of John the Baptist, with a stop at the Machaneh Yehuda market.

Community Focus

- Gain authentic cultural insight during an evening spent enjoying a home-cooked meal with a local family in Nazareth.
- Visit a family owned coffee mill called **El-Babor** to meet the owner and learn about coffee making in the region.
- Spend time visiting a community project with staff from **A Piece of Jordan**. Their goal is to show the real Jordan, where people of all faiths live together.
- Visit the Women's Cooperative Society in the ancient town of Iraq Al
 Amir and see how this social enterprise is allowing them to protect their
 cultural heritage (weaving, pottery making, traditional foods) and
 provide economic support for their families.
- Meet members of the **Shatil NGO** to hear about their work towards a society based on equality of all citizens and residents of Israel.
- Hear the Khoury family story and learn how they came to open the first micro-brewery in the Middle East in the small Palestinian town of Taybeh.
