Biography

Marianne (Shaltry) Gehring, 88 of Harbor Beach, MI passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 19, 2023, at Harbor Beach Community Hospital. Marianne was

born on November 8, 1934, in Saginaw, MI the oldest of twelve children born to John Lawrence (J.L.) and Frances (Cashin) Shaltry. Edward J. Gehring and Marianne Shaltry were united in marriage on April 4, 1959 at St. Anthony of Padua Retreat House in Saginaw, MI. They met at a Catholic Singles Club Dance.

Together with her husband Edward, Marianne with their family, owned and operated Rock Falls Farm just south of Harbor Beach on M-25 where the family raised Registered Belgian Horses and Registered Holstein Cattle. Marianne was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church of Saginaw as a youth and graduated from Holy Family Catholic School. After marriage, Marianne and her husband Edward and family were members of Our Lady of Lake Huron (Holy Name of Mary Parish) Catholic Church of Harbor Beach. Marianne devoted her time to raising her children and worked on the family farm.
