RCIA News

On Sunday, **February 19th at the 11:30 a.m. Mass**, we will be celebrating the **Rite of Sending Catechumens for Election** by the Bishop. The rite asks that the Catechumens "be recognized for their progress" and be sent with the blessings and prayers of the Saint Olaf community.

Those who are completing their initiation through the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist, preparing for reception into the full communion of the Catholic Church, are also included in this rite, since they will be presented to the bishop at the celebration of the Rite of Election for the Catechumens.

The Rite of Election will be celebrated on Saturday, February 25th at The Cathedral of the Madeleine. This rite affirms the Catechumens' readiness for the sacraments of initiation. They will write their name in the Book of Elect, expressing their desire and intent to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at Easter. They are called "the Elect" from this point, indicating they have been chosen, elected, by God and the Church. This is the 2nd major step in the RCIA process.
