America's Great National Parks of the West featuring Theodore Roosevelt National Park, Glacier National Park including the "Road to the Sun", Yellowstone National Park, Grand Tetons National Park, Big Horn Mountains, Devils Tower National Monument and Mount Rushmore National Monument

August 22 – September 1, 2017

Day 1: We'll begin our wonderful adventure to America's great National Parks with an included coffee and roll break. Following our break, we'll continue into North Dakota for a lunch stop on your own. This afternoon we'll take a break prior to arriving in Bismarck for our overnight. This evening we'll enjoy an included Welcome Dinner. (CS, D)

Day 2: An included breakfast starts our day and then we'll continue west stopping to visit Theodore Roosevelt National Park before heading into Montana and stopping for a lunch break on your own. This afternoon we'll stop an afternoon break en-route to our overnight in Billings, MT. The evening will be free to relax and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 3: Following an included breakfast we'll continue west across the Rocky Mountains stopping for a morning break and an afternoon lunch stop on your own to Missoula. Here we'll stop for an afternoon break and then head north along the shores of Flathead Lake to our overnight in Kalispell, MT. On arrival, we'll check into our hotel with the evening free to relax and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 4: Following included breakfast at your leisure we'll board our special Mini-coach with large viewing windows for a spectacular narrated "Road to the Sun" tour through Glacier National Park. You'll hear all about the Black Feet Indian Nation and the Park and we'll make several stops including rest stops, photo stops, Logan Pass, Bird Woman Falls, Big Bend and Valley overlook en-route to the eastern side of the park. In Browning, MT you'll transfer back to our Motorcoach and we'll head south to Great Falls, MT for our overnight. The evening will be free to relax and enjoy dinner on your own. (B)

Day 5: We'll head south after our included breakfast for a real highlight, our narrated cruise on the Missouri River through the "Gates of the Mountain", named by Meriwether Lewis as the Lewis and Clark expedition traveled through here. The cliffs rise 1200 feet above the river on both sides forming a canyon of natural wonders. Later we'll stop for a lunch break on your own and then continue south across the beautiful Big Sky Country of Montana stopping for an afternoon break to our overnight in Livingston, MT. The remainder of the evening will be free to relax and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 6: Following included breakfast we'll head south through the Gallatin National Forest and into Yellowstone National Park. We'll have several photo opportunities today as we'll see a lot of wild life. We'll stop at Mammoth Hot Springs Visitors Center, then drive the north loop stopping at Tower Falls, Canyon Village, Yellowstone River lower falls, Mud Volcano and Lake Village on Yellowstone Lake. We'll then head to Old Faithful to see this world-famous geyser erupt and to have lunch on your own. Later this afternoon we'll visit the Geyser Basin prior to heading to Idaho Falls, ID for our overnight. Our hotel for the night is located right on the beautiful Snake River with the evening free to relax, enjoy the view and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 7: Following included breakfast we'll head east along the Snake River and through the Caribou-Targhee National Forest to Jackson Hole for a morning break. We'll then tour Grand Teton National Park. We'll have several photo opportunities of the magnificent Grand Tetons as we drive Teton Park Road past Jenny Lake to Jackson Lake Lodge for a lunch break on your own. Early this afternoon we'll return to Jackson Hole with the remainder of the afternoon and evening free to explore downtown Jackson Hole and have dinner on your own in this world-famous mountain resort city. (B)

Day 8: An included breakfast starts our day and then we'll head east through the Bridger-Teton National Forest enjoying the beautiful scenery to Thermopolis where you'll see their famous Hot Springs State Park. Later we'll head east across the Big Horn Mountains making a couple of photo stops en-route to our overnight in Sheridan, WY. We'll drive past the historic Sheridan Hotel where Buffalo Bill Cody started his world famous Wild West Show to our hotel for the night. The evening will be free to relax and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 9: Following an included breakfast we'll continue east stopping for a morning break prior to visiting Devil's Tower National Monument. We'll then stop for a lunch break on your own prior to arriving in Deadwood, South Dakota. This afternoon we'll enjoy a guided tour including Boot Hill and Tatonka: Story of the Bison. Later we'll check into our hotel/casino for the night. The remainder of the day and evening will be free to explore Deadwood and have dinner on your own. (B)

Day 10: Following an included breakfast we'll head east stopping to visit Mount Rushmore National Monument prior to heading to the world-famous Wall Drug. You'll have time to explore the store and have lunch on your own. Later we'll continue east stopping for a break prior to arriving at our hotel/casino for the night. This evening will be free to enjoy included dinner at your leisure and the gaming action. (B, D)

Day 11: You'll enjoy an included breakfast and then we'll head east stopping for a morning break and a lunch stop on your own prior to arriving in the Twin Cities late this afternoon. You'll never forget the wonders and beauty of America's Great National Parks of the West. (B)
