Since buying the house in 2015, Wirth's have worked hard to make the property environmentally friendly, specifically using less water.

Wirths replaced much of the lawn with large flower beds filled with perennials, such as echinacea, cranesbill geraniums, and Missouri primrose, to attract pollinators. Children in the neighborhood enjoy walking by and looking for bees in the catmint and snow-in-summer that cover the stone berm at the front corner.

An old maple tree with a split trunk was posing a danger to the house and driveway, so the tree was removed with a Chinquapin oak and two Montmorency cherry trees planted in its place. Five large poplars and an enormous cottonwood were removed in the backyard creating a place for a sitting area, a water fountain, and many other flowering perennials, including some Windwalker red salvia that attract hummingbirds all summer.

A new pergola in the back yard is flanked by two flower beds filled with "Garden in a Box" plants from Resource Central. Greg and Tina enjoy gardening, and their home has been a labor of love!
