East District Commissioner, Chet Owen, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and DeKalb County Clerk, Melissa Meek. Absent Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll

West District Commissioner, Kyle White welcomed those in attendance and East District Commissioner, Chet Owen led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda and approve the minutes from the November 29th meeting with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Jackie Spainhower, Stephanie Williams of North Central Missouri Business Facilitation (NCMBF) and Michelle Fagerstone of NCMBF and Second Harvest met with the Commission to give them an update on things they were working on in the area as well as DeKalb County. Entering the meeting during this discussion was Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll. Discussion was had on services they offer with the Commission stating the need for a technical school in the County. The group agreed to set another time with more individuals to discuss this need.

Christy Humerickhouse of Veregy met with the Commission to give them an update on Sunset Nursing Home. The roofers will be done this week as well as the windows. Doors, gutters, and fascia will be completed next week, and the rooftop units will be tested this week.

Mark Garges and Terry Rumery of Cameron Economic Development met with the Commission asking for the Counties assistance in financial aid to obtain a work force study. They advised that many new businesses are asking for this study when inquiring about coming to the area. The Commission agreed to their request and will give them a onetime payout of \$1,000.00 in exchange for access to the data obtained. The Commission will also give them a letter of support for their endeavors.

Garry McFee of Howe and Company briefly stopped into advise the Commission they had finally gotten their last easement agreement signed for the current project Howe is working on for the County.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the sales tax reports.

Discussion was had on the Sunset Lease. County Clerk, Melissa Meek will contact Attorney Ivan Schraeder for further instruction.

Emergency Management Director, Harold Allison met with the Commission to get approval for the current Hazard Mitigation plan. Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the motion to accept the plan with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor, 3-0 Motion carried.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee presented the adjustment register for all to review and sign.

The Commission discussed debit cards for payment for jury duty. After much discussion the Commission approved this new procedure with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the motion to approve and East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. 3-0 Motion carried. Jurors will receive the card on the day they report for jury duty and upon completion of jury duty the cards will be activated. This will eliminate checks being written and the problem of some checks not getting cashed.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White attended a Tri-County Health meeting and signed checks for Region D.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen attended a MOKAN meeting last week.

Circuit Clerk, Julie Whitsell discussed with the Commission the many concerns with Amendment 3 and how it is now going to affect her office, including additional expense.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman and Chief Deputy Tracy Neill met with the Commission to discuss staff and give them an update on things they were working on.

With no further business before the Commission West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn. Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the second. All in favor. Motion carried.
