



This year:

- Paula Kirkeby Press opened this year with monotype, drypoint, silkscreen, and collagraph classes. The volunteer-based drop-in program is growing with **7 approved monitors and 24 members** making use of the press.
- The 2nd annual Holiday Sale took place on December 1 and 2. The members-only preview was a huge success, as was the public sale on Saturday. The sale earned **\$24,658 in sales and contributions**, doubling from last year.
- The ceramic studio and Foundation partnered to host two pit fire workshops, a wood fire workshop, and a flameware workshop which resulted in **27 new PAACF memberships**.
- Visiting Ceramic Artists Kim Young Soo and Shin Young Taek were on site from Korea from March 19-April 1. Their residency was a huge success! They were very prolific, making a lot of work, building a new raku kiln, and hosting demos here and at our partner organizations (Clay Planet, Higher Fire Clayspace & Gallery, and Sonoma Community Center). The opening reception and artist talk had **72 attendees!** The closing exhibition and members' reception were also well attended with approximately **80+ visitors** admiring and buying the work made during the residency.
- Monday classes started again this year and the studio is now open **seven days a week** for our community artists!

About Adult Studio Program:


The Adult Studio program offers classes and workshops for adult students of all levels in our well-equipped studios. Classes and workshops are taught in a variety of media including ceramics, painting, drawing, jewelry, printmaking, fiber arts, book arts, and collage. The Studios also has a visiting artist program giving our community the opportunity to learn from internationally renowned ceramics artists.
