

42. Further Description of Important Features (Continue on reverse if necessary) This plain, side-gabled building lacks any detailing other than simple frieze boards tacked under the eaves. Windows are located in the first floor walls of the north, south, and west sides; and in the second floor walls of the north, south, and east sides. They occur in 6/6 configurations except for a single sash, 6-light window in the north attic gable. 43. History and Significance This house, as were the others that lined the former road that fronted it, was built by the KIL&T Co. for its quarry workers. All of these houses were rented by the Lime Co. for a nominal monthly fee. Oral tradition suggests that this was one of those structures built to house several single men as a bunk house, originally. c. 1920 it was converted to use by families. One		47.
