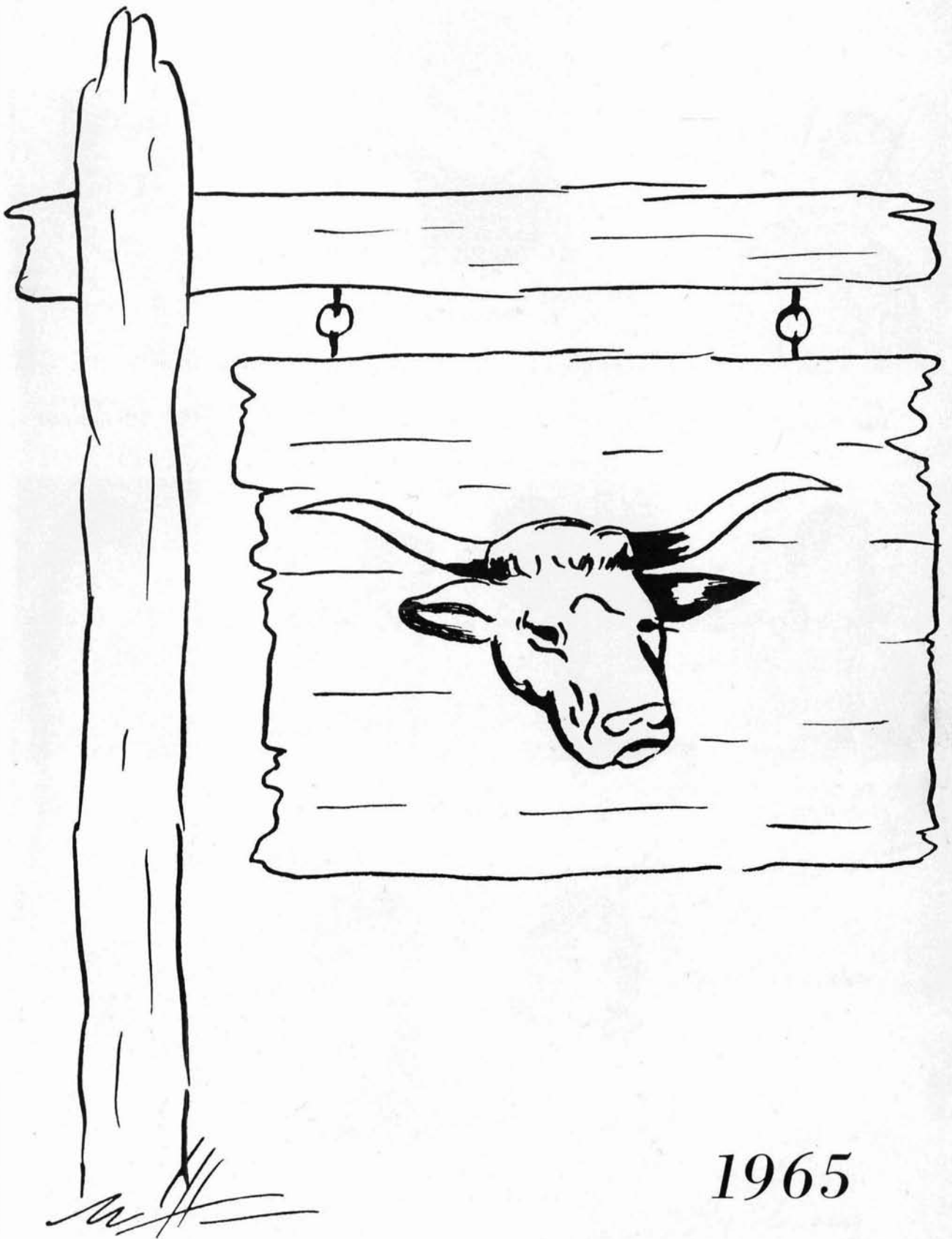

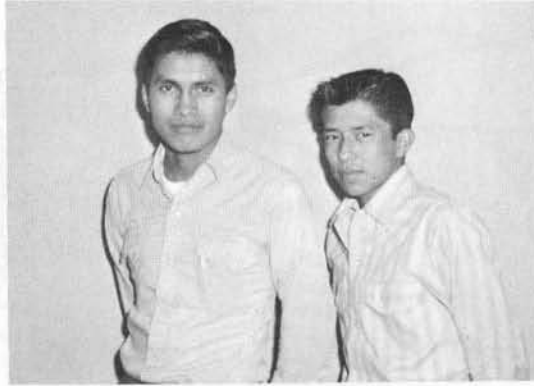

We must also be ever mindful of the great struggle to capture the minds of man today. Many ideologies, some of which threaten the very existence of our democratic principles, are ever present.


