Burn Care Facility service

University Hospitals of Coventry and Warwickshire NHS Trust (UHCW) department of Plastic Surgery is a designated Burn care Facility, providing patient care for non-resuscitation and uncomplicated burns of up to 10% TBSA in adults and 5% TBSA in children.

The Trust is also a Tertiary Level Trauma Centre.

The Plastic Surgery department has 6 consultants, 4 SAS grade surgeons and 4 trainees under the West Midlands Plastic Surgery rotation, who are experienced to provide surgical management and follow up of the burns cases. A dedicated Clinical Nurse Specialist available to provide the follow up care in the dressing clinics and physiotherapists and occupational therapists to provide necessary input for patients who need their support.

One Adult ward (ward 32) and three Childrens wards (ward 14 for adolescent, ward 15 for <1 year old, and ward 16 for toddlers) are the designated wards to receive Burn injured patients requiring an inpatient stay.

A dedicated CNS will be available to provide the follow up care in the dressing clinics. We have liaised with the physiotherapists and occupational therapists to provide necessary input for patients who need their support.

We will strive to constantly improve the services and undertake audit projects to do so. Patients with complications and in need for higher levels of burns expertise will be referred to Queen Elizabeth Hospital Birmingham and Birmingham Children Hospital.
