

## Winnebago-Boone Farm Bureau 2023–2024 Grant Application

WBFB is funding this grant program to support projects underway by local FFA chapters, as well as 4-H clubs. The recipients will be able to use the grant for supplies for a project or a program.

In order to be eligible for a grant, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ *The applicant must be a member of the 4-H club or FFA chapter.*
- ✓ *The applicant must submit a typed application to describe the project.*
- ✓ The applicant's FFA Advisor/ 4-H leader must sign the application.
- ✓ *The applicant's parent/guardian must sign the application.*

The recipients will be chosen based on the completion of the above requirements, along with a 5 to 10-minute oral presentation of the project and its details at an upcoming board meeting.

Applications will be reviewed by the Education Team and approved by the Board of Directors.

If awarded a grant, the recipient will be required to submit a summary of the program or project. This includes photos of them utilizing the products and detailed receipts for purchases.

Once all requirements are met and approved, grant funds will be awarded.
