**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE,  
COLORADO, AMENDING THE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF  
MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN  
OF MARBLE, COLORADO FOR THE BANK RESTORATION FUND DURING THE  
FISCAL YEAR OF 2000.**

WHEREAS; the Town of Marble desires to renovate the historic Marble City/State Bank Building; and

WHEREAS, the Town has received revenues in the form of donations in amounts exceeding amounts appropriated for fiscal year 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to expend these revenues on the restoration of the Marble City/State Bank Building.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, ORDAINS THAT:

1. The 2000 appropriation for the Bank Restoration Fund is hereby increased from \$0 to \$2,000 for the following purpose:

To use as matching funds for grants to renovate the historic Marble City State Bank Building, and to raise additional funds.
