

# Sew Fun! Sewing School

Sewing is a creative way to build/develop: patience, focus, problem solving and self-confidence.

## Sewing Class Descriptions

### Sewing Year 1 : 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade (Pre-Requisite: None)

Classes are designed for the beginner as well as students with some sewing experience. Students will learn sewing machine parts/functions, how to layout, read and understand basic patterns. Students will also learn how to properly pin and cut fabric, and how to straight stitch and zigzag. Lessons will start with our *Sew Fun! Sewing School First Year Workbook*. All students are encouraged to complete sewing projects at their own pace.

**Tuition:** \$75; **SFSS Workbook:** \$40; **Registration Fee:** \$20 (sewing tools/supplies used during class- scissors, seam gauges, rulers, straight pins, needles, marking pencils, interfacing, KCS patterns, etc.)

### Sewing Year 2 - 4: 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade (Pre-Requisite: 2 semesters of SFSS Sewing Classes)

Classes are designed for students that completed **2 or more semesters** of sewing classes. Students will build on previously learned sewing skills with the goal of gaining more independence. Students will continue using a SFSS Workbook and progress to teacher selected commercial patterns. All students are encouraged to complete sewing projects at their own pace.

**Tuition:** \$75; **SFSS Workbook:** \$35- \$40; **Registration Fee:** \$20 (sewing tools/supplies used during class- scissors, seam gauges, rulers, straight pins, needles, marking pencils, interfacing, patterns, etc.)

### Teen Sewing Year 1-4: 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Grade (Pre-Requisite: None)

Classes are designed for the beginner as well as students with some sewing experience. Students will learn sewing machine parts/functions, how to layout, read and understand basic patterns. Students will also learn how to properly pin and cut fabric, and how to straight stitch and zigzag. Lessons will start with our *Sew Fun! Sewing School Teen/Adult Workbook* and progress to teacher selected commercial patterns. All students are encouraged to complete sewing projects at their own pace.

**Tuition:** \$75; **Workbook/Patterns:** \$35; **Registration Fee:** \$20 (sewing tools/supplies used during class- scissors, seam gauges, rulers, straight pins, needles, marking pencils, interfacing, patterns, etc.)

### **Adult Sewing: 18 and up (Pre-Requisite: None)**

Classes are designed for the beginner as well as students with some sewing experience. Students will learn sewing machine parts/functions, how to layout, read and understand basic patterns. Depending on the class projects, additional skills taught may include: how to take measurements, read a pattern envelope to determine your pattern size and how to read pattern instructions to cut and construct a sewing project. Lessons will start with our *Sew Fun! Sewing School Teen/Adult Workbook* and progress to teacher selected commercial patterns. All students are encouraged to complete sewing projects at their own pace.

**Tuition:** \$75; **Workbook/Patterns:** \$35; **Registration Fee:** \$20 (sewing tools/supplies used during class- scissors, seam gauges, rulers, straight pins, needles, marking pencils, interfacing, etc.)

## ***Fashion Design Descriptions***

**Fashion Design Junior:** 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade (Prerequisite: 2 semesters of SFSS Sewing Classes and teacher recommendation.

**Semester 1 and 2:** Classes are designed for students with some sewing experience. Students will learn **Fashion Design Basics/Introduction:** Students will learn about a career as a fashion designer, the history of fashion, and designers who define fashion history. Students will also get an introduction to: **Fashion Design Elements:** color, line, silhouette, texture/fabrics; **Fashion Design Principles:** balance, rhythm, proportion, emphasis. Students will experience the **Fashion Design Process** as they use teacher selected commercial patterns for inspiration to sketch designs. Students will select a final design and fabrics. Finally, students will observe how to make adjustments to the pattern and sew their designs. Students will have homework.

**Tuition:** \$75; **Workbooks/Markers:** \$45; **Registration Fee:** \$20 (sewing tools/supplies used during class- scissors, seam gauges, rulers, straight pins, needles, marking pencils, interfacing, patterns, etc.)

**Fashion Design I:** 6<sup>th</sup> Grade and up (Prerequisite: 2 semesters of SFSS Sewing Classes and teacher recommendation .

**Fashion Design II: 7<sup>th</sup> Grade and up (Prerequisite: 2 semesters of SFSS Sewing Classes and teacher recommendation)**

**Semester 3 and up :** Classes are designed for students that have completed Fashion Design I. Students will use their knowledge from Fashion Design I/Semester 1 to gain a better understanding about **Fashion Design Elements:** color, line, silhouette, texture/fabrics; **Fashion Design Principles:** balance, rhythm, proportion, emphasis. Students will experience the **Fashion Design Process** as they use commercial patterns for inspiration to sketch designs. Students will select a final design and fabrics. Finally, students will observe how to make adjustments to the pattern and sew their designs. Students will have homework.
