GENERAL/BREAKOUT SESSIONS

Communal Engagement (Rev. Anthony Holmes)

It's important that youth ministry is geared towards kingdom building not only inside of the four walls of the church but also in the community at large. As a body of believers it is up to us, to make sure that we properly engage with our community in such a way to offer physical support but also uplifting the name of Jesus Christ while doing so.

Spiritual Development (Rev. Marvin Gilliam):

It is important for us to remember that what we do and how we interact will have some effect on their spirituality that will follow them for the rest of their lives.

Social Involvement (Rev. Michael Moore):

Many movements across the country, have been started by youth and young adults alike, who desired to take a stand against the social ills that still linger in this land.

Mental Health Awareness (Dr. Jessica Young-Brown):

Youth workers are often times one group of the “first responders” to address the issues that young people experience and it is important to first understand the various mental health factors that can exist in our communities.
