## ANIMAL CONTROL INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN JOHNSON COUNTY AND THE CITY OF VIENNA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Johnson Coun	ty has established an	Animal Control	Program, f	or the
unincorporated areas of the C	ounty, by adopting an	Animal Control C	Ordinance, the	
day of, in	concurrence with the	State of Illinois A	nimal Contro	ol Act;

WHEREAS, within the incorporated limits of the VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. there is a need for animal control; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. wishes to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with JOHNSON County, who will provide animal control in accordance with the established JOHNSON County Animal Control Ordinance, including any additions or amendments to said Ordinance the JOHNSON County Board of Commissioners may deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. and the County of JOHNSON are legal entities organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, having among their powers to contract with one another to perform such undertakings as described herein.

JOHNSON County agrees to provide animal control in and for the VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. in accordance to the guidelines set forth in the existing JOHNSON County Animal Control Ordinance adopted the including any amendments or additions to said Ordinance that the JOHNSON County Board of Commissioners may deem necessary.

The VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. agrees to execute and support incompliance with the JOHNSON County Animal Control Ordinance.

JOHNSON County and the VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time with a sixty (60) day written notice acknowledged by the receiving party within the dates of this agreement.

The regular business hours of the JOHNSON County Animal Control will be from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Animal Control will respond to calls from any resident of any City/Village during regular business hours. After regular business hours, Animal Control will only respond to emergency calls or requests to respond by city/village, state, or county law enforcement.

The VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. agrees to compensate JOHNSON County for providing animal control at the rate selected below per person, based on the 2020 population reports, supplied by the US Department of Commerce, Bureau of Census.

Animal Control will send a statement to collect the yearly fees November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year beginning in November 2026. This is your statement to collect yearly fees for the time period of May 1<sup>st</sup> 2025 to December 31, 2026. All fees must be paid within a timely manner according to Meeting dates of each Village/City. These fees pay for every service of the Animal Control and no additional fee will be paid by the City/Village. The only additional fees that will be collected will be from customers for adoptions, surrenders, etc. and such fees are not the responsibility of the City/Village.

The VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. will have two options regarding the length of this contract. The VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. may opt for either a one-year contract or a three-year contract. Additional forms are attached, one for each type of contract. The VILLAGE/CITY OF VIENNA, IL. should sign only the appropriate form and return the same with this contract.

**POPULATION** OF EACH CITY/VILLAGE IS BASED OFF OF THE 2020 CENSUS AND WILL REMAIN THE NUMBER OF PERSONS UNTIL THE 2030 CENSUS IS PUBLISHED.

#### OPTION ONE- THREE-YEAR CONTRACT

Under this option, the city/village will pay \$4.99 for the first year of service, May 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026. The rate will then increase by \$2.00 per capita per year through the year 2028. The per capita population for the duration of the contract will be based upon the 2020 United States Census.
