Meta Trost Farver, age 95 of Pigeon, passed away Tuesday, August 24, 2010 at the Huron Medical Center in Bad Axe.

Born on July 18, 1915 at the family homestead in Elkton, she was the daughter of the late Henry F. and Marie (Fluegge) Trost and graduated from Cross Lutheran School in Pigeon. On February 20, 1938, she was united in marriage to Melvin F. Farver at Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon. He preceded her in death

on February 16, 1992.

In her early years, Meta was a pastry chef at the Statler Hotel in Detroit, and continued baking privately. Over the years, she made many wedding cakes for people in the community. She worked as a pharmacy assistant for 27 years at the Scheurer Hospital pharmacy.

Meta enjoyed baking and cooking, and spending time with her family. She was formerly active in the Dorcas Society. She was a member of the Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon.

Her survivors include two daughters, Janalou (David) Blecke of Beaverton and Karen A.
