#### 2024 Blue & Gold Tournament Rules & Regulations

#### **Entry Requirements**

Participation is open to any 2023-2024 high school sponsored bowling team. The maximum number of teams at each tournament is limited to thirty-eight (38). Teams will receive their spot based on the date the paid entry is <u>received</u>. **Unpaid entries will NOT be accepted by telephone or email.** 

**Tournament Format** The same format will be used for D1 and D2 competitions and both boys and girls divisions.

Five bowlers per team. Team roster limited to eight (8) bowlers.

Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl three (3) team games followed by a break, followed by 5 baker games. Based on the total scores from the Qualifying Round, eight (8) teams in each division will advance to the Championship Round. All ties for advancing teams will be broken by a 9th and 10th game roll off. Scores will not carry over to Championship Round.

Championship Round: The top eight (8) teams in each division will advance to a 2-game, total score head to head baker format bracket. All ties for advancing positions broken by a 9th and 10th game roll off.

#### Awards

The first place team will receive a team trophy. The members of the first and second place teams will each receive medals. The eight members of the all tournament team in each division will receive medals.

Saturday (D2) Schedule: Check in begins at 11:00 am \* Coaches Meeting will begin at 11:45 am \* Practice starts at 12:00 pm Sunday (D1) Schedule: Check in begins at 9:00 am \* Coaches Meeting will begin at 9:45 am \* Practice starts at 10:00 am

This tournament will observe the rules and regulations of participation and play of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA).

A coach is free to sub any bowler at any time for any reason in any frame or game "at will". However, the game score will not be credited to either the starting or replacement bowler during the team games.

An 8 person All Tournament Team will be named based on scores from the qualifying round. A boys and girls All Tournament Team will be determined for both D1 and D2 competitions.

The tournament manager is empowered to make on site changes, including lane assignments and balancing the gender teams to fill the field the best way possible.

Admission for spectators will be \$8.00. Each team may admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers and two coaches at no charge.

Additional information including complete schedule and lunch menu will be emailed to the team head coach upon receipt of entry and payment.

All lane assignments will be determined by tournament director.

The lane pattern for this event will be a challenge pattern.

No outside food or drink may be brought into the bowling center.
