us so generously. Please take with you our gratitude and the hope that you will come back to visit now and then. May God bless you richly in all that your future holds.

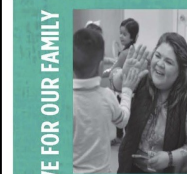
Please plan to join Father at his last Mass with us on Monday, June 28, at 12:00 pm to bid him Godspeed in his new assignment.

In keeping with the Archdiocese's desire to provide a safe environment for all members of the church in western Washington especially for minors and vulnerable adults all parish employees and volunteers in service to the church must participate in the VIRTUS Safe Environment Training Program in addition to having a background check if you fall into any of the following categories:

- Any volunteer with access to minors or vulnerable adults in their volunteer capacity are required to have a background check every three years, a training class every three years, and to have read and signed the Safe Environment policies at least once.
- Any volunteer with access to money (cash, checks, or other negotiables) is required to have a background check every three years.
- Any volunteer who drives on behalf of the parish is required to have a background check every three years.

VirtusOnline - www.virtusonline.org - is the site which you can log on to and see the status of your existing background check. Every three years a new one needs to be run and the system will send you an email to begin that process if necessary. If you do not have an email address, a manual form can be signed to get the process completed. NEW CHANGES AS OF 6/26-27/21 CONGREGATIONAL SINGING CHANGE

Going forward, we are allowed as a congregation to sing the Gloria; Our Father; Holy, Holy, Holy and Lamb of God and Amen. We understand that congregational singing is still not encouraged for the processional, offertory, communion and recessional hymns. As we will not have a Cantor for the 4:30 pm Vigil Mass the Mass parts will be spoken and not sung by the congregation at that Mass. Remember, masks must still be worn.

Seating Changes as of 6/19-20/21

- Masks are still required for everyone.
- You may notice that we have opened up more seating in our nave. Seating will now be available with no restrictions or social distancing required.
- We still recognize that some parishioners will continue to want to sit socially distanced, so for those of you who choose to do so, we have a designated area in the front and middle of the church for you—where the white ropes are.

Ongoing Safety Practices:

- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the church and you are encouraged to use it and hand washing is encouraged.
- We may not have social gatherings before or after our Masses.
- Please continue to self screen for COVID symptoms and if present please remain at home for the safety of all. Please see the COVID warning signs on the back page of this bulletin.

We are getting there and your help is as always much appreciated. Our wonderful parish community is a precious and cherished gift to us all and well forth the effort in continuing to jointly protect it until we can once again open our doors freely without any restrictions.
