OBI Live Scan Office & Mobile Unit Fingerprinting Instructions

The Office of Background Investigations pleased to announce that we are now providing fingerprinting services to DHS applicants!

OBI opened a Live Scan office in the Sequoyah Building, located in C-26, on July 1, 2016. Hours of operation are Monday – Friday from 8:00 am until 5:00pm.

The OBI Mobile Fingerprinting Unit will visit 15 county DHS offices each month, to assist DHS applicants obtain fingerprinting services. Please beware that these counties may change, as new vendor sites are opened in areas currently under served by Live Scan vendor sites. Hours of operation are Monday – Thursday from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm. Current Mobile Unit Schedule will be shared when it is available.

Criminal History Background Checks are a two part process:

- 1. Schedule an appointment for fingerprinting at www.identogo.com or 1-877-219-0197.
- 2. Submit a criminal history review request form electronically at https://bidspublic.okdhs.org. (*This link only works on Non-DHS network computers. To access this form from a DHS network computer use: https://lro.prod.okdhs.int/requestinternal.aspx)

ECAO ACCREDITATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- **1. Award Description** The Accreditation Scholarship is given to programs that have demonstrated an ability or willingness to meet the standards associated with NAEYC Accreditation. This scholarship is intended to help deserving programs have the opportunity to pursue or maintain Accreditation by receiving financial assistance.
- 2. Award Distribution In addition to receiving a financial award to help defray the cost of NAEYC Accreditation fees, an Accreditation Specialist will work with the program to answer questions that may arise concerning NAEYC Accreditation. The number of awards provided depends on available annual funding. Applications are reviewed by the Accreditation Scholarship committee and are presented to the Early Childhood Association of Oklahoma (ECAO) Board for final approval. Applications will be reviewed three times a year corresponding with the General submission dates set forth by NAEYC. Notification will be sent at least 60 days prior to the next submission date to allow funds to be available to the recipient before the due date.

3. Nominations Those submitting an application should be able to: ☐ Demonstrate a knowledge of the NAEYC Accreditation Process and Requirements
☐ List SMART(Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Realistic, and Timely) goals for meeting the NAEYC 10 Standards
☐ Have a working knowledge of the NAEYC Code of Ethical Conduct.
4. Requirements Those wishing to apply must: ☐ Be an ECAO member
☐ Be in good standing with state licensing and have a minimum of a two star status

- **5. Restrictions** Programs may only apply for one scholarship per year. For example, if you are applying for scholarship for Application/Self-Study you may not also apply for a scholarship for Candidacy within that same year.
- **6. Recognition** Recipients will be recognized in our newsletter and may be asked to provide a follow up statement to highlight how the funds helped the program.
- **7. Application** It is preferable to e-mail your application to ecaokof-fice@gmail.comt. If you must send by mail, download the application and fill out by hand (attaching essays, reference letters, nomination letters, etc.), and mail to:

Summer Science Fun

Elephant Toothpaste

This exciting science experiment works great in a discussion on reactions, as a demonstration, or as an actual experiment. To use it as an experiment, perform it once with your child, then ask your child what might happen if you changed the amounts or left out an ingredient. Let her direct the experiment! Also, the foam created is safe to touch. It is simply water, oxygen gas, and soap, so if your child has no soap allergies, she can experience and experiment with the texture of the foam!

How to make Elephant Toothpaste:

- 1. Set a soda pop bottle in the middle of a pan to catch the toothpaste.
- 2. Mix these in a separate container and swirl together for a minute.
- ** 2 Tablespoons warm water
- ** 1 teaspoon yeast
- 3. Mix these in your soda pop bottle
- ** 1/2 cup 6% hydrogen peroxide.

is important to use at least 6%. You can use 8% or more (available on Amazon), or you can use Salon Care Professional Stabilized Formula. 20 Volume Clear Developer from Sally Beauty Supply works fine too. 3% from the grocery store will NOT work as well. :)

- ** 4-5 drops food coloring
- ** squirt of dish soap
- 4. Pour the yeast mixture into the soda pop bottle and be amazed!



How to Make a Rain Cloud

- Water
- Shaving cream
- Food coloring or liquid watercolor
- Dropper or pipette for liquid watercolors

Start by putting a large dollop of shaving cream on top of a jar of water. Talk to the kids about how the water droplets rise in the air and condense on dust particles. A huge group of them together is a cloud. Explain that in this demo the shaving cream is the cloud.

Add drops of liquid watercolor or food coloring. Once it gets saturated enough it will start to rain. Juist like in a real cloud.
