In the Old Testament, the names of individuals are meaningful, and a change of name indicates a change of status. God's name is used throughout the Old and New Testament over 2,300 times. Each of God's names, are a term used for His identification and are meaningful for us.

God is a self-complete being, "I AM WHO I AM" (Exodus 3:14) and there is no other. "ELOHIM" (or Elohay) is the first name for God found in the Bible. El is the simple form arising from Elohim, and is often combined with other words for descriptive emphasis concerning who He is. He has all these names because His name means -above all names.

I love to think and meditate on His names and on how God is beyond measurement! He is everything we need when we need it. This means He is boundless, inexhaustible, unlimited and immeasurable. He cannot be defined by size or amount because He has no beginning, no end, and in Him there are no limits (Romans 11:3).

My prayer is that in reading this today, God would open your eyes to see another truth of who He is and the infinite eternal value of His greatness towards you.

God is everywhere. God is infinite! He is in and around everything, always close to everyone. Does He not fill heaven and earth? All that God is, He has always been. All that He has been and is, He will ever be. He is ever perfect and completely unchanging.

God is omnipresent and is greater than all creation for it was by His hands that everything came into being. He is higher than the nations or any idol fashioned by the finest craftsman.

God is all-knowing. His knowledge encompasses every possible thing that exists, has ever existed, or will ever exist. He is all-knowing and all-powerful, and by His sovereignty He rules His entire creation.

Nothing is a mystery to Him because He is omniscient. He holds all power in His hands. He will do exactly what He said He would. He will provide whatever is needed, because He said so.
