Subj: Major Reforms to Streamline Military Acquisitions

Dear Hon. Dep. Secretary of Defense Feinberg:

During his speech to the generals on September 30, Pres. Trump suggested that Sec. of War Hegseth "will soon be announcing major reforms to streamline military acquisitions."

Please review recommendations for major reforms that are in the following, previous letters. The recommendation to eliminate the Earned Value Management Systems (EVMS) requirement has already been applied all acquisition pathways except major capability acquisitions. Now, eliminate DFARS EVMS clause completely.
