

Ordinance No 205

An Ordinance restraining Billiard and Pool Tables and other instruments for sport and games and requiring licenses therefor.

Section 1.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, That it shall be and is unlawful for any person or persons, company or corporation to keep for hire or pay, within the corporate limits of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, any billiard table, pool table, bagatelle, alley or other machine, instrument, appliance or devise for sport or game, without first procuring from said Town a license so to do.

Any person, persons, company or corporation convicted of violating any of the provisions of this section of this ordinance shall be fined therefor in any sum not less than one nor more than fifty dollars, for each and every such offense.

Section 2.

And be it further ordained that any person desiring to obtain a license to keep for hire or pay, directly or indirectly, within the corporate limits of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, any billiard table, pool table, bagatelle, alley or other machine, instrument, appliance or devise, to be kept in any place for sport or games shall file with the Clerk of said Town a statement in writing, showing for what game and table or devise he desires a license and the place where he designs keeping the same and specially describing the room where he intends to so operate the same, and he shall pay to the Treasurer of said Town the sum of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each table, alley, bagatelle, instrument, machine, appliance or devise of any kind, for which a license is . . . Upon such statement being filed and such sum or sums of . . . first paid as aforesaid said Clerk shall issue to said . . . a license to keep for hire or pay upon . . . premises in
